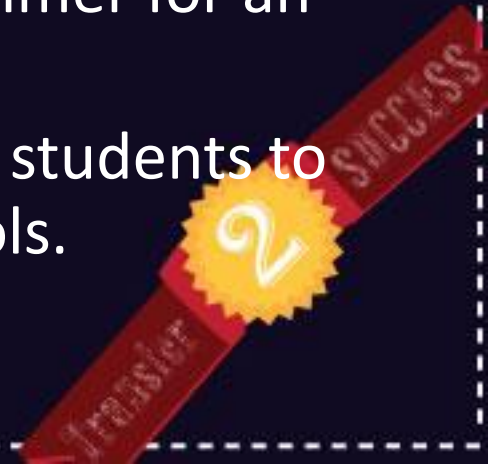

# Transfer 2 Success

- Why

- Transfer students participate in a very short orientation and do not register for Learning Community classes both which provide information about the IUPUI campus, the School of Engineering and Technology, and resources available to students
- On-time graduation
- True 2 + 2 transfer students have one summer for an internship
- Faculty teaching 300 level courses expect students to know how to use Oncourse and other tools.



# Transfer 2 Success

- Who
  - Any transfer student
  - Required for Atlanta University Consortium students (scholarships)
- Students are eligible to receive a \$100 book allowance

- What
  - Resource page emailed to admitted transfer students before summer begins
    - Information on Oncourse, OneStart, Weeks of Welcome, Tips for parking, etc.
  - Kick Off 2 Success
    - Half-day program; 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday after classes in conjunction with ET New Student BBQ
      - Get your ACT together (Academic, Campus, Technology Resources) and Career Development (What you need to know NOW!)
